Tweed's Premiere Tribute to Elvis Festival will take place from August 26 - 28, 2011. Festival organizers have been busy setting an event schedule which will include Tribute Artist Competitions, Collectibles Vendors, and Local Events.

It all begins on Friday, August 26 with the Opening Ceremony at 6:00 p.m. at Tweed Fairgrounds. The first round of Elvis Tribute Artists (ETAs) will run from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m.

Saturday & Sunday will both begin with a Pancake

Breakfast from 8:00 to 11:00 a.m. at the Lions Hall on Victoria St. in Tweed.

The Vendors Village will run both Saturday & Sunday at the race track.

A licenced refreshment tent and a canteen will be available.

A Saturday night dance will be held next to the Fairgrounds at the Land O'Lakes Curling Club.

The Tweed Heritage Centre will have an Elvis collectible display & Garden Tea on Saturday.

An Elvis Tribute Parade on Sunday will travel from Tweed Park to the Festival

grounds at 10:00 a.m.

An Elvis Inspirational Hour will take place on Sunday at 11:00 a.m.

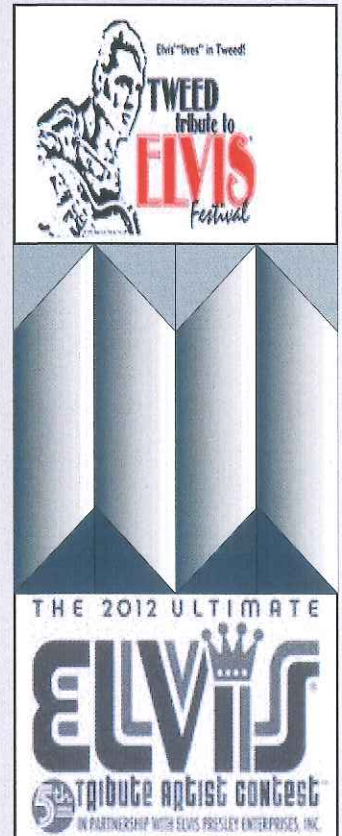
The Finals of the ETA Competition will be held from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. & this will be followed by presentations & the Closing Ceremony.

thank the countless people who made private donations.

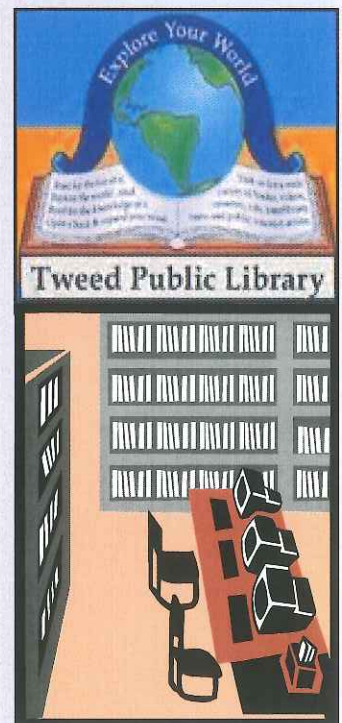
Without this financial assistance this dream would not have materialized for our municipality.

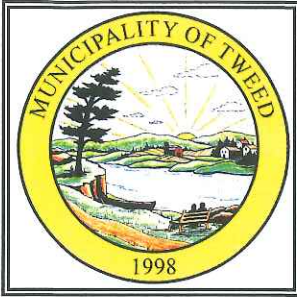

2011 CAPITAL BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

- Municipal office renovations including new customer service counter, painting & carpeting, & outside signage.
- Municipal building energy efficient upgrades including new gas fired boilers & replacement of old windows.
- Completion of new zoning by-law.
- Electronic speed limit signs at Village boundaries.
- Purchase of new vehicles including fire rescue vehicle, tractor, mower & tandem truck.
- Bridge repairs.
- Rural roads projects including prep work on portions of Lynch & Palmateer Roads; tar & chip portions of Vanderwater, Kenner & Flinton Roads; continuation of gravel application on approximately 40 kms.
- Urban roads projects including completion of River Street project & sidewalk replacements.
- Replacement of arena ice surface lights.
- Fountain for lake at Tweed Memorial Park.
- Continuation of upgrades to municipal water & sewer systems.
- Accessible upgrades at municipal halls in the hamlets - Federal Government funded projects.

The total residential tax rate for 2011 is 0.0126500. The 2011 municipal residential tax rate portion decreased by 7% over 2010. The overall 2011 tax rate decreased by 6.2% over 2010. The tax rates for all other tax classes including commercial, farmland, managed forest, multi-residential & industrial, etc. are calculated as a percentage of the residential tax rate.
