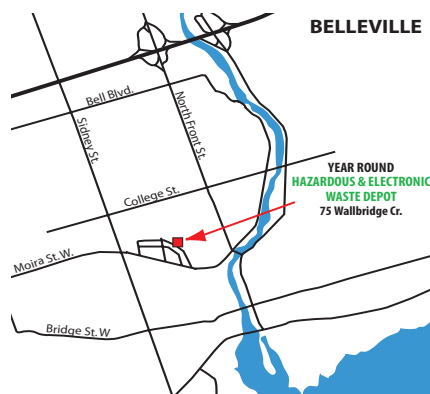

Quinte Waste Solutions is the operating name of the Centre and South Hastings Waste Services Board.

Nine municipalities sit on this Board. It is a not-for-profit, municipally operated service.

Hazardous and electronic waste that we receive at our main year-round depot in Belleville, or at any of our mobile events is categorized, packaged, and shipped to be either recycled, re-used, or safely disposed of.

Industry, that creates some of the material that is hazardous, helps cover operational costs. The rest is covered by municipal levies.

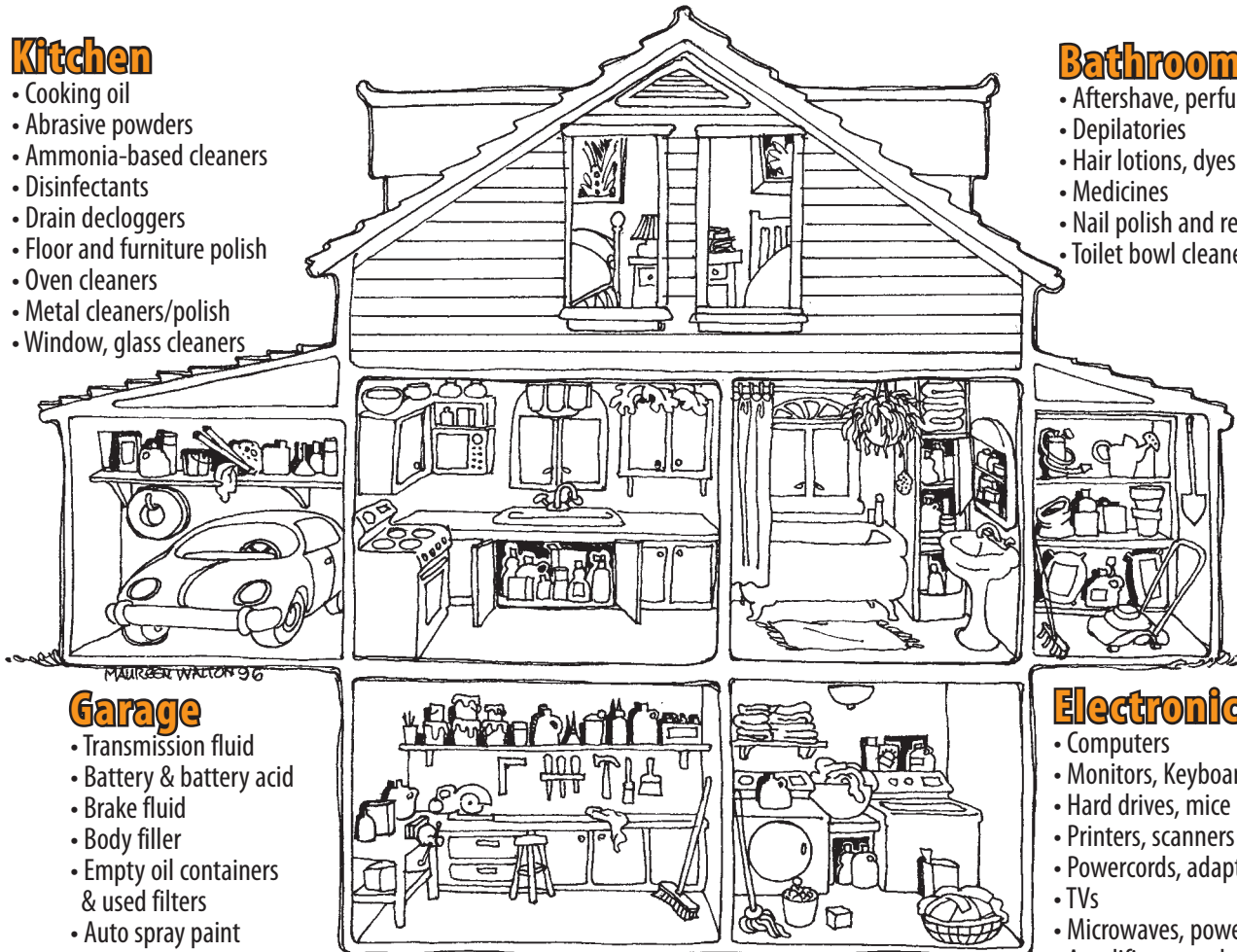
Do I Have Hazardous or Electronic Waste?

- Abrasive powders
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Disinfectants
- Drain decloggers
- Floor and furniture polish
- Oven cleaners
- Metal cleaners/polish
- Window, glass cleaners

Bathroom

- Aftershave, perfume
- Depilatories
- Hair lotions, dyes
- Medicines
- Nail polish and remover
- Toilet bowl cleaner

- Transmission fluid
