



Replacement of Rapids Bridge Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study (Schedule B) for the Municipality of Tweed

Notice of Study Completion

Introduction

The Municipality of Tweed has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) to determine the preferred solution for the replacement of the Rapids Bridge. The Rapids Bridge is located approximately 6km west of the Village of Tweed on Rapids Road in Hungerford Township, in the Municipality.

The Process & Preferred Solution

The project is proceeding in accordance with a Schedule B Undertaking of the MCEA to address the identified condition of the bridge and potential risk to the public and the local environment. As part of the study, alternative solutions were reviewed, with due consideration of the natural, socio-cultural, and economic environments. Based on the findings of the study, the replacement of the bridge with dual corrugated culverts is the preferred solution that best minimizes potential impacts to the environment.
