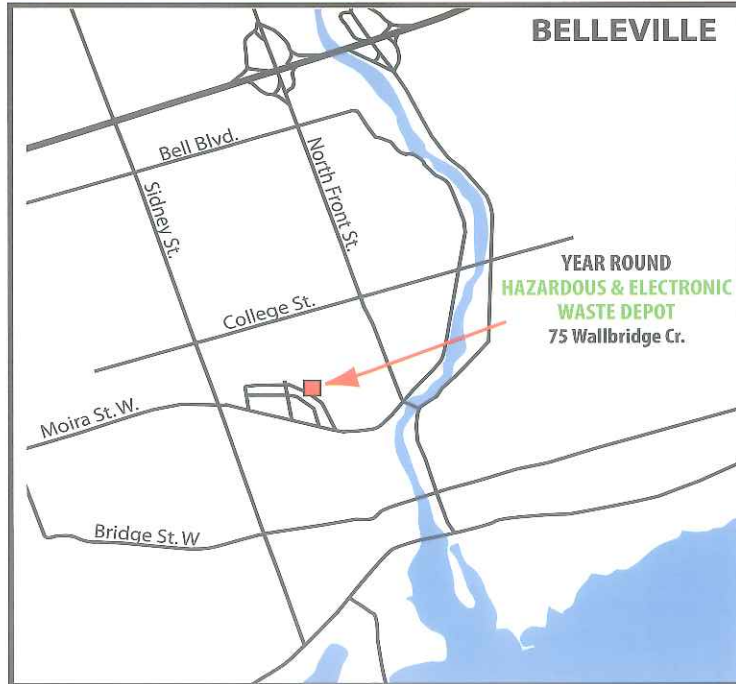

- 1 When you purchase products... Consider non-toxic alternatives.
- 2 If you have toxic household products in your home now... Use them all up.
- 3 If you still have toxic products that need to be disposed of... Take them to the Household Hazardous & Electronic Waste Depot.

## WHAT IS THE HARM OF HAZARDOUS AND ELECTRONIC WASTE GOING TO LANDFILL?

Hazardous & electronic wastes contain harmful chemicals and toxic heavy metals. In a landfill, these toxic materials will leach into the soil and waterways contaminating our drinking water and the environments where we live and play.

When you responsibly dispose of your hazardous & electronic waste you're saving money, protecting the local environment and ultimately being a good neighbour.

## HOW DO I KNOW IT'S HAZARDOUS?

Products found in the household that have hazardous characteristics may display one of these four symbols identifying the hazard.



### POISON

A product with this symbol may cause injury, illness or death if ingested.



### FLAMMABLE

The product or its fumes will catch fire easily if it is near heat, flame or spark.



### EXPLOSIVE

The container can explode if heated or punctured.



### CORROSIVE

This product can eat or wear away many different types of material, including skin.

**No symbol?** Look for words like "wear gloves" and "fumes may be harmful"
