

CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TWEED

BY-LAW NO. 2006-25

Being a By-Law to alter the one way direction on a street in the Municipality of Tweed.

WHEREAS Part III, Sections 24 to 68 of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides the specific municipal powers given to councils regarding highways;

AND WHEREAS Section 34 (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that public notice be given prior to the passing of a by-law for the altering of a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed deems it expedient to change the one way direction on a municipal highway;

AND WHEREAS public notification of this change has been given in accordance with the Municipality's by-law for the giving of notice;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed enacts as follows:

1. In this By-Law "highway" shall include a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle designated and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles.

2. That the following one way directions for vehicular traffic be hereby established:

The one way direction on Spring Street from Victoria Street to Colborne Street shall be in an easterly direction.

The one way direction on Spring Street from Victoria Street to Metcalf Street shall be in a westerly direction.

3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed.

Read a first and second time this 20th day of June, 2006.

Read a third and final time, passed, signed and sealed in open Council this 20th day of June, 2006.
